I will respect all of my fellow coaches & officials of the games and follow all league guidelines for playing time, league rules and scoring.

I will put my emotions aside and keep the physical well being of my players ahead of a desire to win and maintain control of myself while coaching. Never to show gestures or use inappropriate language that can be deemed as hostile or humiliating to my team, our league or this department.

I will refrain from questioning an official's decisions in a disrespectful manner during a game and if there is a safety concern, I will go to the site coordinator and league director for assistance.

I understand that there is to be no music allowed in the form of boom boxes, sound systems, radio units, etc to be used during practices and games and that all basketball events must be free from drugs, alcohol, vapes and tobacco.
