

MONROE PARKS AND RECREATION YOUTH TRAVEL BASKETBALL PROGRAM INTEREST LISTS 2025-2026 SEASON

The Monroe Parks and Recreation Department will be holding tryouts soon for our youth travel basketball program that is in our third season. If your child is planning on trying out you must register them on our interest list and pay the try-out fee of \$25.00. If you make one of our teams, the try out fee will go towards your total due for participating. If you do not get selected, this fee will go towards the registration for the our youth recreation league. There will be no refunds. Head to our website: www.MonroeRec.org to get on our list.

Depending on the numbers this could dictate the final layout of teams to be actually offered. This is NOT the recreational youth league we already run. We are looking to enter teams in the Milford Knights League and/or the Fairfield County Basketball League, plus additional games with area travel teams.

This program is limited to Monroe year round youth residents and based on your current grade for the 2025-2026 school year. Fees will be announced based on which leagues we enter, uniform packages and how many totals teams we end up forming collectively. There will only be one team per grade group based on Interest/skills seen at the upcoming tryouts and we can't promise every grade will have a team as we may have to combine. Possible teams are for both boys and girls currently in 5th grade through 8th grade. Not everyone makes a team. Volunteer coaches will be needed for certain grade levels as some of our coaches are returning. It is not promised that if you played last season with us that you would be selected again. You may also register & play in our recreational league concurrently.
