DESCRIPTION

I. Job Summary

Monitor aquatic facilities in order to ensure safety of patrons as well as assist Head Lifeguard/Recreation Supervisor with the supervision, scheduling and training of other lifeguards.

II. Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Maintain constant surveillance of assigned areas of pool/beach and patrol locker rooms.
- Monitor aquatic patrons enforcing all rules and regulations to minimize or eliminate accidents and hazardous situations.
- Help to determine the opening and closing of aquatic areas with respect to weather or other health and safety issues.
- Perform water rescues and administer emergency first aid.
- Teach multiple sessions of public swimming lessons.
- Participate in all seasonal training sessions and conditioning programs.

- Recommend purchases and monitor inventory of first aid, rescue and safety supplies and equipment.
- Perform any other duties that are necessary to operate and/or maintain the Department's facilities.

III. **Minimum Qualifications**

- A. Education: N/A
- B. Experience: Minimum age of 18 years or older. Prior Lifeguard II experience or equivalent with at least 16 weeks success at another aquatic facility.
- C. Skills and Abilities: Must have a current American Red Cross Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED certification as well as American Red Cross WSI certification. Must pass pre-season water tests in the pool and lake with considerable proficiency. Must have ability to act calmly and effectively in an emergency situation. Willingness to work as part of a team, with flexibility to do whatever is required. Availability to work the summer season, including nights and weekends, requiring minimal time off, if any.

IV. **Physical Requirements**

Must possess the physical skills necessary to execute lifesaving aquatic rescues and administer first aid. Outdoor work during the summer season, including nights and weekends.

V. **Work Environment**

Indoor pool environment as well as outside pools and beach.
